



## **Curl Moncton Inc.**

### CHASE THE ACE GAME – IN GENERAL & PREPARATION

#### ***The Organization***

- Curl Moncton Inc. – Business # 803452606NP0002
- Lottery License # 1528310 131 001 - issued 28-June-2018

#### ***Outlining the Game***

The *Curl Moncton Chase the Ace* is a form of Lottery, where Raffle Tickets are being sold. Each week participants buy lottery tickets. The funds from ticket sales are divided weekly into three parts. **20%** of the week's generated sales go to the holder of the week's winning ticket.

**30%** of the week's generated ticket sales go into the progressive jackpot.

**50%** of the lottery income stay with the organizer.

The holder of the weekly winning ticket, or their surrogate (if holder is not in attendance), will have the opportunity to choose a card from the official game deck. The week's winning ticket holder will win the jackpot should they or their surrogate choose the Ace of Hearts.

If the Ace of Hearts is not drawn, the reduced deck is kept for the following week's game. ... and so forth.

The jackpot accumulates from week to week until it is won, and the game is then over. At this time Curl Moncton Inc. will apply for a new draw license.

#### ***Objective of the Game***

Curl Moncton Inc. strives to be a self sustainable organization, which continuously integrates new initiatives for developing the skills of our Little Rocks in particular, including Physical Literacy and the beginning of a curriculum for teaching curling at age-appropriate levels.

The new building expansion with its additional sheets will allow us to grow our Club in a way we could not with only five ice sheets. The funds of the *Curl Moncton Chase The Ace* Lottery will assist us in achieving these goals.

#### ***Preparation Chase the Ace, Curl Moncton***

On a weekly basis during the lottery, one member of the Curl Moncton Chase the Ace Committee, or their representative will be assigned to act as Draw Master for that week's draw.

## CHASE THE ACE GAME – RULES & INSTRUCTIONS

### **(A) Dates and Timeline**

- A,1) The start for the first Curl Moncton Chase the Ace Raffle Lottery will be in September 2018
- A,2) Tickets will be sold during the week before each draw date during operating hours of Curl Moncton, as well as on each Draw Day between 2:00 and 4:00 p.m. On the Draw Day, Curl Moncton Inc. reserves the right to extend the hours for ticket sales to accommodate patrons. In the case of such an extension, the additional time will be limited to a maximum of 2 hours. Ticket sales will end 15 min. prior to the draw. Any changes to ticket sale hours will be posted via social media.
- A,3) Draw date will be every Saturday during the period of the Lottery. First draw is planned for Saturday, September 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2018.
- A,4) The maximum of a game period is up to 52 weeks.
- A,5) There will be weekly sales of tickets and one weekly draw each Saturday until such time that the Ace of Hearts is drawn for the disbursement of the Jackpot.
- A,6) In the event of weather or other circumstances that prevents Curl Moncton Inc. from holding the weekly draw on Saturday, the draw will be held on the next available day. Any change to the regular weekly Draw Day will be posted via Social Media.

### **(B) Purchase of Raffle Tickets and Pricing**

- B,1) Raffle Tickets will be sold at Curl Moncton Inc., 80 Lockhart Ave, Moncton during regular business hours from Sunday through to Saturday afternoons.
- B,2) Tickets can only be purchased with cash.
- B,3) Last call for ticket sales is 15 min. before draw of the ticket, which is planned for 4:15 p.m.
- B,4) Purchase prices for the Raffle Tickets are structured as follows:  
\$5.00 for one (1) ticket / \$10 for three (3) tickets / \$20 for ten (10) tickets
- B,5) Ticket sales are restricted to people 19 years or older

### **(C) The Draw Day**

- C,1) Set up at Curl Moncton Inc., 80 Lockhart Ave, Moncton
- C,2) First Draw date will be Saturday, September 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2018
- C,3) Tickets will be available between 2 and 4 p.m. every Saturday
- C,4) 4:15 p.m. Ticket Draw
- C,5) 4:20 p.m. Draw of the game card
- C,6) Draw attendance at Curl Moncton, 80 Lockhart Ave will be limited to the capacity permitted by the Fire Marshall. All draws will be broadcast live on Facebook to provide access to all ticket purchasers.



#### **(D) Prizes and Winning**

- D,1) For each individual draw week, that week's Draw Master and Draw Volunteers working at the Live Draw on site, are not eligible to claim a prize for that week.
- D,2) Winning Raffle Ticket on each draw date will be guaranteed to receive 20% of the moneys that got generated in the week of the Raffle Ticket sales prior to the draw.
- D,3) The holder of the winning ticket does NOT have to be present on the draw day.

- D,4) Each week's draw will be broadcast live on Facebook.
- D,5) The colour of the winning ticket and number will be called out repeatedly at the location and shown on the live broadcast. Each week the ticket number and colour will be recorded for audit purposes.
- D,6) The Winning Card for the Jackpot is the Ace of Hearts.

- D,7) The progressive Jackpot amount is 30% of the tickets sold to date. This amount continues to grow each week that the Ace of Hearts is not pulled from the deck of cards.
- D,8) The Jackpot will start with a \$2,500 contribution from Curl Moncton Inc.

#### **(E) Procedures for Drawing the Weekly Winning Ticket \***

- E,1) The Curl Moncton Chase the Ace Committee will assign a Draw Master for each weekly draw conducted. It will be the duty of the Draw Master to oversee the weekly draw and ensure that all rules and procedures are followed.
- E,2) It will be the responsibility of the Draw Master to enforce the Rules of Play, and if necessary, make a ruling to manage any situation that arises, as outlined in the Rules of Play.
- E,3) The Draw Master will have final word in the enforcement of the rules for the weekly draw.
- E,4) At the pre-established time as outlined in the Rules of Play, the Draw Master will announce the weekly result of ticket sales. As outlined in the Rules of Play, 20% of the weekly ticket sales will go to the owner of the ticket drawn for that week, 30% will go to the accumulating Jackpot, and 50% will go to Curl Moncton Inc.
- E,5) The announcement of the weekly results will be done live at Curl Moncton, as well as broadcast live on Facebook. The results will also be posted on a display board. The announcement of the weekly results will be done before the process of selecting the weekly winner begins.
- E,6) At the established time, the Draw Master will randomly select a person in attendance to choose the weekly winning ticket from the drum.
- E,7) The chosen person to pull the winning ticket will turn their back to the drum, put one hand in the drum and select ONE ticket. The winning ticket drawn from the drum will be clearly shown and handed to the Draw Master. The Draw Master will announce the winning ticket colour and number. It will also be shown on camera for Facebook Live and posted on the Facebook page.
- E,8) It is critical that the person chosen to select the winning ticket select only ONE (1) ticket. The following procedures will be used if the person selected to draw the winning ticket removes more than ONE (1) ticket from the drum:



- a. Should the person accidentally pull TWO (2) tickets from the drum, the person pulling the tickets will hand both tickets to the Draw Master. The Draw Master will show that TWO (2) tickets have been pulled. The person selected to pull the ticket will turn their back to the Draw Master, and the Draw Master will place one of each of the two drawn tickets in each closed hand. The person selected to draw the winning ticket will then select a closed hand. The ticket in the chosen hand will be the winning ticket for that week's draw.
  - b. Should the person accidentally pull MORE THAN TWO tickets from the drum, the tickets will be handed to the Draw Master. The Draw Master will show that MORE THAN TWO tickets have been pulled. The Draw Master will return ALL the pulled tickets to the drum, and the process will be restarted with a new person selected to pull the winning ticket.
- E,9) Once the winning ticket has been established and announced, the Draw Master will wait five (5) minutes for the owner of the winning ticket to come forward. The owner of the winning ticket does not have to be present at the draw to win. Should the owner of the winning ticket not come forward to be identified within the five (5) minute period, the Draw Master will randomly choose a person in attendance to act as a surrogate; to select a card on behalf of the winning ticket holder for the opportunity to win the progressive jackpot. The surrogate selected to act on behalf of the winning ticket holder has no claim to either the weekly 20% prize money or the 30% progressive jackpot money.
- E,10) All remaining cards in the draw will be placed face down on a table and shuffled/randomized. The owner of the winning ticket, or their assigned person should they not be present, will choose one card from the table. The first card they touch on the table will be deemed to be the card chosen. The card will be turned over and displayed by the Draw Master to all in attendance, both live and for the camera.
- E,11) If the card chosen for the weekly draw is the Ace of Hearts, the weekly winner will win the 30% progressive jackpot, in addition to the 20% of that week's ticket sales.
- E,12) If the card chosen for the weekly draw is NOT the Ace of Hearts, the card will be marked "VOID" and removed from the deck of remaining cards. All cards removed during the process of the weekly draws will be recorded and retained for audit purposes.
- E,13) If the card chosen for the weekly draw is NOT the Ace of Hearts, the 30% jackpot amount for that week will be added to the progressive jackpot amount for the next weekly draw.
- E,14) The weekly winner will have 72 hours from the time of the draw to come forward to claim their prize. Should the weekly winner not come forward within the assigned time frame, that week's prize money (20% of week's ticket sales and 30% of jackpot amount if applicable) will be added to the progressive jackpot for the next week's draw.
- E,15) At the conclusion of the week's draw, the Committee will record the following for audit purposes:
- a. The winning ticket number and colour
  - b. The total amount of cash ticket sales
  - c. The breakdown of that week's cash sales, 20% to the weekly winner, 30% to the progressive jackpot, 50% to Curl Moncton
- E,16) At the conclusion of the week's draw, the remaining ticket stubs in the drum from that week's draw will be destroyed, and the process will start new for the next week's draw.
